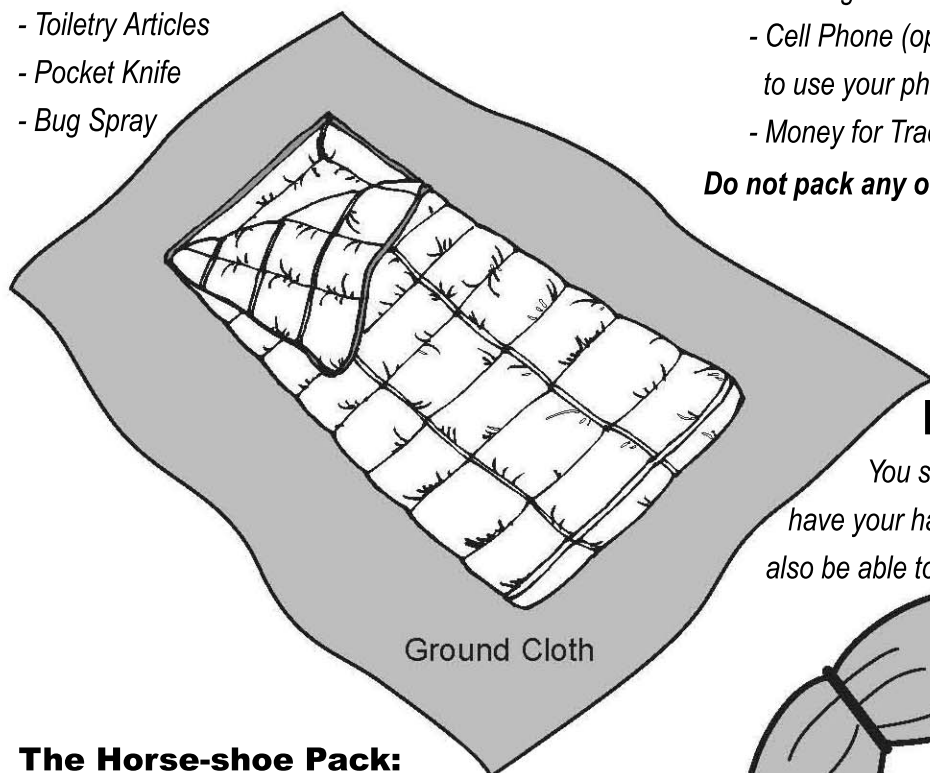


Ordeal Packing Instructions

You should prepare two packs for your Ordeal weekend. Below you will find everything that is needed for the first night of your ordeal and how you can prepare this gear using the Horse-shoe pack method.

Gear Needed

- Sleeping Bag and Ground Cloth
- Large (10' x 10') Piece of Plastic and Twine/Rope to be used as a Tent in case of rain
- Rain Gear (keep rain gear handy if chance of rain)
- Gloves / Work Clothes (you will get dirty)
- Personal Water Bottle
- Toiletry Articles
- Pocket Knife
- Bug Spray



The Horse-shoe Pack:

Lay your Ground Cloth and Sleeping Bag flat. Place other Items on one edge of the Ground Cloth. Roll the Ground Cloth and Items toward the opposite edge and tie both ends securely. Add extra ties along the length of the bundle and connecting the two ends with a line.

Be Prepared - You will sleep out under the stars with only the equipment you bring from the list above. In the case of severe weather, you will be provided some additional cover.

All other gear should be packed separately and is to be stored until the following day.

Additional Gear

- Official Field Uniform (Scout Shirt, Pants, etc.)
- Change(s) of Clothes
- Extra Shoes
- Flashlight
- Cell Phone (optional - you will not be allowed to use your phone until Saturday evening)
- Money for Trading Post (optional)

Do not pack any of this gear in your first night pack.

First Night Pack

You should be able to wear your pack and have your hands free while you walk. You should also be able to remove or pick-up your pack easily.
